



Visitor Oyster Card.

We are pleased to provide you with a Visitor Oyster Card for travel on all London Transport during your site inspection, including the underground (tube), London buses and the Docklands Light Railway.

Your card has been credited with £25.00. Each underground journey in Zone 1 costs £2.40 (it is cheaper for bus travel). The most you will pay in one day is £7.00, so if you undertake more than three journeys you will have reached the one day price cap and so all subsequent trips that day will be free of charge.

Please use your card this week to join us for all of the planned activities. If you use all of the credit we have provided, there is a simple way to top up your card (see below). Your card will still be valid in December, so do bring it back with you if you have any credit left over.

How to use your Oyster Card.

When you approach the entry barrier at any underground station, or jump on to a London bus, all you need to do is to place your card on the yellow disc reader (see picture). The reader will beep and will show you the value that is left on the card. On the underground, the barrier will open for you to walk through while on the bus, the driver will acknowledge your payment and will allow you to enter.



NOTE: On the underground, it is very important that you also place your card on the yellow disc reader when you exit the network, otherwise you may be charged more for your journey.

What journeys are included during your group travel programme at New Year?

- Travel to and from the four Audio Tours.
- Journey back to your hotel from The Tower of London.

PLEASE NOTE: The amount of credit we provide on the card does not cover journeys you take in your unstructured time (unless you have reached the one day price cap). If you need to top up your card, you may visit one of the ticket machines in the main lobby of any underground station. You place your card on the yellow disk reader and the screen will show how much credit you have. You then select how much you wish to top up, confirm your preferred method of payment, either credit card or cash, and make the payment. It is very important that you place your card back on the yellow reader again to update it.
